Description:

Located in one of the most sought-after areas of Los Damunts, this enchanting village house with 120 years of history and an area of 153m² has two floors and an inviting inner courtyard.

The first floor impresses with a cozy living room, a guest WC and an open kitchen with adjoining dining room, which leads directly to the idyllic inner courtyard. From here, an exterior door leads to a small, enchanted cul-de-sac that exudes typical Mallorcan charm.

On the second floor there are three bedrooms, a dressing room, a bathroom with bathtub and a storage room. The master bedroom and the kitchen are equipped with air conditioning. The floors are tiled and the exposed wooden beams throughout the house give an authentic and warm atmosphere. The robust structure is based on 60 cm thick load-bearing walls, while the façade is clad with Mallorcan stone and the roof is covered with Arabic tiles. Traditional Mallorcan shutters complete the picture.

A large public parking lot is located just a few meters away.
