This impressive new construction project with enchanting far-reaching views is located not far from the village centre of Algaida, Mallorca.

On a 20,450 m² plot, the design of the house harmoniously combines Mallorcan finca style with a classic modern style, both in appearance and design. The property of 250 m² living space is planned as a single-storey structure, with a garage attached at the end with space for three cars. There will be 4 bedrooms and 4 bathrooms, 3 of them en suite, as well as a further guest toilet. The entire plot will be closed with a typical Mallorcan dry stone wall. The generous infinity pool has a water surface of 34 m² with the dimensions of 3.4 x10.3 metres. The price quoted includes the completed "turnkey" construction of the house.

Location:

Algaida is a quiet village in the central part of Mallorca, about 22 kilometers east of Palma. Surrounded by rolling hills and rural countryside, it is easily accessible via the MA-15 and MA-5010 highways. In the center is the historic parish church of San Pere y San Pau. In the surrounding area, the Randa sanctuary on the Puig de Randa offers impressive panoramic views. Known for its traditional windmills and wineries, Algaida lives mainly from agriculture. The town preserves a rich tradition and celebrates numerous local festivals that characterize its cultural life.
