Description:

This historic villa on a large plot (building land) is situated in La Vileta, Palma de Mallorca. It is a quiet, sought-after location approx. 3.5 km north of the city centre. The villa has an area of approx. 472 m² and is divided into main house and staff house. The main house has 2 floors, 8 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, high ceilings and beautiful Hidráulico floors. In addition, there are about 79 m² for the double garage and storerooms. One use would be to renovate the villa and use it as a stately family home with a large park-like garden. It should be no problem to build a pool.

The other possibility is to divide the large plot (approx. 2512 m²) and build several detached or terraced houses. The building law allows dense building (min. plot size 100 m², max. height 6.5 m + basement, "Ocupación" 50%, "Edificabilidad" 70%). According to a preliminary study, 16 terraced houses can be built on plots of approx. 150 m² each with a building volume of approx. 100+ m² each (+ basement with a garage). The property has access from two roads. Sewerage is available in front of it. Please ask us for further information or to arrange a viewing.
